WHO ARE WE?



Herefordshire Growing Point is an award-winning charity that works with vulnerable people, in the county.

We provide therapeutic gardening sessions for the disabled and elderly at our purpose-built demonstration garden within the Holme Lacy campus. Sometimes we work with our clients in their own residential or daycare setting. Importantly, everyone belongs to a group at HGP and the social benefits are enormous. We have been watching friendships develop for the last 25 years.

With one part-time member of staff, a team of tutors, and a group of volunteers, we offer weekly sessions for our clients (accompanied by their carers). We operate in our specially adapted garden which has raised beds and a polytunnel. The Garden Room (also our office) provides a small indoor space with basic amenities for refreshments and craft work.
